- 1. Print the form
- 2. Fill in your name, email and phone number (mailing address if you want shirts shipped to you shipping is \$5/shirt)
- 3. Fill in the number, type and size of the shirts you would like to order (all of the shirts tend to run small, so order up a size)
- 4. Add it all up to determine the total amount of your order
- 5. Return the form to us in one of two ways:

 - b. Give the order form and check/cash to a board member
- 6. All orders forms must be accompanied with payment
- 7. If you would like your shirt(s) mailed to you, please add S&H to this order form. Otherwise we will email/phone you to arrange pick-up when the shirts come in.

- Starting a native aquatic plant re-vegetation program in areas cleared of milfoil by DASH
- Exploring and planning milfoil abatement program in LBL
 - Hiring a professional consultant
 - o DASH
 - o Benthic mat
 - o Re-vegetation with native aquatic plants
 - o Preservation of Cisco fish
- Continuation of lake monitoring through the Cooperative Lake Monitoring Program (CLMP) in both Big and Little Bass Lakes
 - o Vigilant monitoring for new invasive species
 - Exotic Plant Watch
 - Detailed characterization of the shorelines
 - Score the Shore
 - Water quality tests for health of fish, turtles, etc. and control of algae growth
 - Total phosphorus
 - Dissolved oxygen and temperature
 - Secchi disk
 - Chlorophyll
